Purpose

You will report to the General Management. You will provide specific assistance to children and adolescents with relational, learning, behavioural and/or integration difficulties in order to facilitate their development and their social and educational integration. In addition, you will collaborate with the medical and pedagogical teams as well as with the parents and other stakeholders.

Main Duties

- In liaison with the pedagogical team, identify children with psychological, relational or behavioural difficulties;
- Provide advice to students with personal, social or academic difficulties;
- Actively collaborate with the pedagogical team and provide them with the most appropriate tools to psychologically support or help students with difficulties;
- Participate in pedagogical meetings about students with difficulties;
- Refer parents, if necessary, to available and competent services outside the school;
- Provide training for staff on topics determined with the Management;
- Work in close collaboration with the Management, the teaching team and the medical team.

Required Qualifications and Skills

- Master's degree in child and adolescent psychology, psychotherapy, clinical psychology or neuropsychology;
- Excellent command of English and French;
- Interest in multidisciplinary work and team work;
- Excellent organisational skills;
- Flexibility and collaborative spirit;
